Laminated Glass Warranty

Glass Enterprises, Inc. warrants its laminated glass products for a period of five (5) years from the date of substantial completion against defects in material or workmanship which result in edge separation, let-goes, or de-lamination, and in the case of laminated insulating units, film formations or dust collection between the interior glass surfaces that materially obstructs vision.

This warranty does not cover glass breakage, de-lamination, or edge separation due to installation, cleaning or handling procedures not in accordance with industry standards, sealant incompatibility, diameters, design or engineering failure, units installed in high humidity areas, or units installed within 500 yards of salt water.

In the event of a failure of any laminated glass product as the result of defects covered by this warranty, Glass Enterprises, Inc. may supply a comparable product, no charge, F.O.B. nearest common carrier terminal to place of installation, of the company may, at its option refund the original purchase price paid to Glass Enterprises, Inc. for the product, prorated over the warranty period to reflect the time during which the product has been free of defect. If a comparable product is supplied, the warranty of the replacement shall be for the balance of the original warranty period, and Glass Enterprises, Inc. will endeavor to match the replacement product with its other products used on the project, but will not (because it can not), guarantee the replacement or be otherwise acceptable in terms of color or appearance. The replacement of the product, or the company's option, the refund the original purchase price paid to Glass Enterprises, Inc. for the product under this warranty, shall be the purchaser's sole and exclusive remedy for any failure, including any failure resulting from negligence or breach of contract on the part of Glass Enterprises, Inc., its suppliers, employees or agents.

The foregoing warranty is exclusive. Glass Enterprises, Inc. makes no other warranties, whether expressed or implied, including warranties of merchantability and fitness for particular purpose or end use.

The company will not pay nor give credit for any incidental, special, or consequential damages such as, but not limited to, labor costs for any purpose, inconvenience, damage, or injury to person or property, or any other expenses resulting from such failure.

As a condition to establishing liability, Glass Enterprises, Inc. requires the purchaser to give written notice of the alleged defect to Glass Enterprises, Inc., headquarters at 2277 New York Avenue, Bensalem, PA 19020. Glass Enterprises, Inc. reserves the right to have any products alleged as having failed, field inspected by a qualified factory representative and/or returned to the factory for inspection.
